Fur traders will inhabit the area all three days. Folk music played on traditional instruments, voices raised in hearty harmony, and the rhythmic thud of cloggers mark the weekend.

Then, there's the food! Chili, freshly popped black kettle caramel corn, hotdogs and brats, and more soothe appetites sharpened by the cool air.

Friday is special for seniors: Bus tours are welcome and group packages can include step-on guides, a historic driving tour and a ride on the authentic river boat.

The Historical Society Museum is open all three afternoons. There is also a bicycle color tour on Saturday, and a narrated boat cruise and nature walk on the Ledges on Saturday and Sunday at 1:30

Autumn is celebrated with pioneer demonstrations and fall related activities. The smoky smells of blacksmithing mixed with the crisp scents of freshly pressed cider evoke memories of our past.

Children can cuddle the bunnies and pet the sheep and llamas in the petting zoo. Try a craft or even crank a corn sheller.

Weaving, basketry and more round out the family festival.
