

## Grand Ledge Area Chamber of Commerce Hires New Director

The Grand Ledge Area Chamber of Commerce announces the hiring of Jill Russell of Lowell, Michigan to assume the role of Executive Director. Russell began her duties on Monday, October 22, 2012. Earlier this year, a subcommittee was formed to establish a framework for a new Executive Director position. After the Chamber board voted to proceed with the search and a number of resumes were received, Brian Metcalf, Superintendent of Schools for Grand Ledge and Maris Brennan, owner of the local Snap Fitness franchise, interviewed seven candidates. Subsequent interviews with the finalists were conducted, with the Chamber board

voting to extend an offer to Russell at its most recent meeting. "When we began this process last summer, I wanted it to be a very open and transparent, with no pre-conceived notions as to who our next Executive Director would be," said Eric Dean, President of the Chamber. "I think we accomplished that goal and I believe that our members and the entire Grand Ledge community will see what the rest of us saw in Jill in the months and years to come." Since the fall of 2007, the Grand Ledge Chamber has been operating almost entirely under the direction of volunteers. This hiring will allow the Chamber to expand its outreach and advocacy significantly and help to bring even more benefits to its members. "I am very excited for the opportunity to work with all of you," said Russell. "I look forward to getting to know everyone in Grand Ledge and helping to fulfill the Chamber mission by promoting the economic, recreational and historical attributes of the Greater Grand Ledge Area."

A welcome reception for Jill Russell will be held on Thursday, November 1st from 5:30—7pm at the Grand Ledge Area Chamber of Commerce office, located at 220 S Bridge Street. Chamber and community members are encouraged to attend.
