PROCEDURES AND POLICIES

The Eaton County Health Department is requiring you to give us copies of your food handling license and your liability insurance. Please enclose with your registration and check.

The Grand Ledge Area Chamber reserves the right to deny registration of Yankee Doodle Days Festival vendor applications. The Grand Ledge Area Chamber of Commerce sponsors the Yankee Doodle Days Parade to celebrate Independence Day, on behalf of the Grand Ledge Community and Businesses. To provide an exciting, but safe and organized event, we ask all participating organizations to comply with our operating procedures and policies displayed on the back of this application.

*Non-discrimination: The Grand Ledge Area Chamber of Commerce, Yankee Doodle Days Festival Committee welcomes the participation of all people regardless of age, creed, national origin, race, religion orientation and asks all participants organization to also engage in non-discriminatory actions. All registration forms must be reviewed and approved by the Yankee Doodle Days Festival Committee. The Yankee Doodle Days Festival Committee reserves the right to deny any registration form.

*Vendor Image: Participants are requested to show respect for all people and organizations and be aware that children will be in attendance at this event.

*Vendor Booth:

-Length: Units cannot be longer than authorized lot space provided.

-Decoration: Booths can be decorated. Tables and chairs are not provided by the Chamber.

-Safety: No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances will not be permitted at your booth; food vendors will need an appropriate Eaton County license/permit and liability insurance.

*Clean Booth Area: We do request you maintain a clean booth area and not allow trash or other obstacles to accumulate around your booth during open display time.

Distribution: Sexually explicit materials may not be displayed or sold or handed out. Care needs to be taken to ensure the safety of participants and people attending the Yankee Doodle Days Festival of events.

*The Grand Ledge Area Chamber of Commerce will expect you to have your booth or unit open to the public as prescribed by time and days on this vendor application.

*Vendor Cancellations: It is understood that this contract is non-cancelable. Payments made will be forfeited for early withdrawal.

*Location: The provided space allotment will be provided by the Grand Ledge Area Chamber of Commerce, which will be on the Island Park right off West River Street. There is limited electrical power and water supply and arrangements need to be made with the Chamber office if this will be a requirement for your booth.
